Reporting Criteria

If the Spanish screener score is being used to determine at-risk status, students in 5K will be identified as “at risk” and require follow-up diagnostic assessment if their aimswebPlus Spanish Early Literacy Composite score is below the 25th percentile during any of the testing windows. The Kindergarten Spanish Early Literacy composite score combines performance on Spanish Letter Naming Fluency (SLNF) and Spanish Letter Sounds Fluency (SLSF).

Kindergarten students with Spanish Early Literacy composite scores in Fall <1, in Winter (Mid-year) <27, and Spring <55 are performing below the 25th percentile.
