# <u>Digital Record Form (DRF)</u> All pre-K to Grade1 measures and ORF Grades 1 through 12



- Individually administered
- Requires printed forms for students
- Teacher easily marks student responses on computer
- Built-in timer and directions
- Auto scored

#### <u>TestNav</u> Grades 2 to 3 online measures



- Group or individually administered
- Standardized directions are found in the aimswebPlus Help Library
- Headphones required for group administration
- Must be unlocked through aimswebPlus
- Students log in via a downloaded app or the web with a username and password or with SSO
