is an assessment program covering all disciplines that aligns to national standards and offers candidates flexibility in obtaining licensure and certification. The Series™ features remote testing with online proctoring, a free Interactive Practice Test with every registration, and customized data reporting for State Agencies and Educator Preparation Programs.

The edTPA is a performance-based portfolio assessment intended for initial teacher licensure/certification or preparation program completion. edTPA provides performance feedback to candidates on key constructs of effective teaching. Programs make use of edTPA data as part of their continuous improvement process. edTPA was developed by Stanford University faculty and staff and is delivered by Evaluation Systems. is a voluntary assessment program designed to develop, retain, and recognize accomplished teachers and to generate ongoing improvement in schools nationwide. This performance-based assessment has twenty-five certificates across a variety of subject areas for teachers seeking National Board Certification. Assessments have a strong emphasis on content knowledge, differentiated instruction, teaching, learning environments, and becoming effective and reflective practitioners.
