



# Medication Review Before Clinical Assessment Testing

A list of medications that may interfere with cognitive performance appears on the subsequent pages of this document. The column on the far left categorizes the medications into two groups. The following table explains the two groups and the actions you should take if an examinee reports taking medication(s) from either of these groups.

	<p><b>Excluded Medication:</b> Examinees taking these medications <i>cannot</i> be tested.</p>
	<p><b>Medication OK Without Serious Side Effects:</b> Examinees taking these medications may be tested <i>only if they do not report any of the serious side effects listed in the question below.</i></p> <p>Verbally ask the examinee:</p> <p><b>When you're taking [name the medication on the list] do you:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• feel very tired or sleepy;</li><li>• have very slow reactions;</li><li>• have very poor concentration or attention;</li><li>• feel highly agitated or distressed;</li><li>• have very poor memory; and/or</li><li>• have high levels of shaking, trembling, or tremor (due only to medication, not a medical condition like essential tremor)?</li></ul> <p>Do <i>not</i> test an examinee who answered “<b>yes</b>” to any of the serious side effects in this question.</p>





















If a medication does not appear anywhere on the list, it is acceptable for examinees to be taking it when tested.
