Neutral assessment of general problem-solving skills

Universal screening for giftedness is important to identify all students that may be gifted. Non-native English speaking students and those with disparate cultural experience, learning capabilities, previous education, and socioeconomic backgrounds, may struggle with test formats and content. The Naglieri Nonverbal Ability Test® (NNAT®) is the research-based solution for this problem. It is a standardized test that assesses nonverbal reasoning skills using the relationships between figures or diagrams.

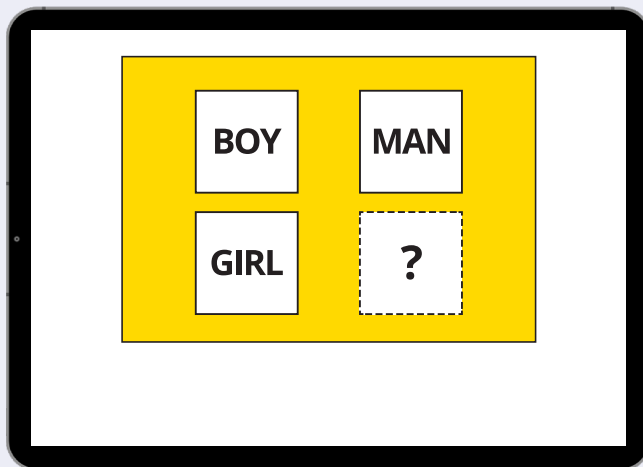
Since 2004, the NNAT has been a trusted name in general ability testing for student populations because:

- Has minimal language and directions

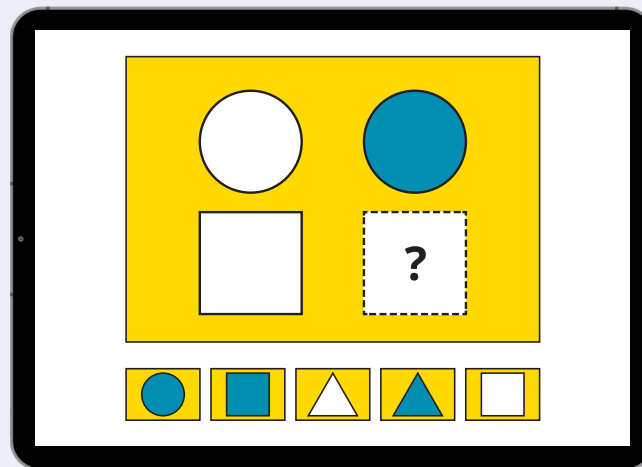
NNAT is an assessment that provides neutrality, quality, and reliable data that educators need, and students deserve.

How it works

Traditional ability tests use words instead of graphics for many items. To correctly answer these types of questions, students may need to understand both the language and context of the question. Instead of using words, NNAT uses diagrams. This approach eliminates barriers.



In the above example, BOY is to MAN as GIRL is to ?— the answer is WOMAN.



In the case above, the student must determine which shape, from the five options shown, should go in the box below the blue circle, which of course would be blue square.

Administration and evaluation

The third edition of this popular assessment is a group-administered test that requires approximately 30 minutes to complete by paper or online. The test provides pictorial direction to expedite testing administration and instruction. Education professionals, including bilingual educators, testing coordinators, gifted and talented teachers, special education teachers, functional life skills facilitators, counselors, and school psychologists, all utilize NNAT3 to place children in appropriate educational programs.

Seamlessly evaluate the entire student population

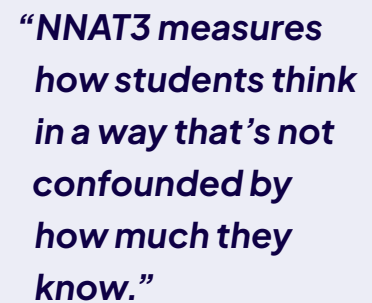
